Proof of Health Exam and Immunizations Required:

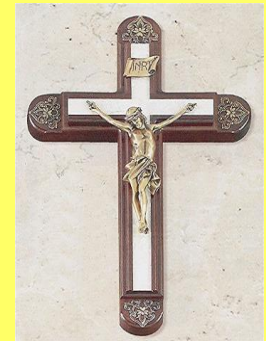

Failure to provide proof of required health exams and immunizations (by October 15) shall result in the child being excluded from school until the parent/legal guardian presents proof of the exams and immunizations, and the parent/legal guardian is deemed in violation of the Illinois School Code during the period of noncompliance.
